1. All entries to be grown or home-made by the entrant
2. Product to be named (e.g. Tomato Sauce)
3. The maker / artist must not be identified on or near the item
4. All jars must be sealed with solid lids
5. Please feel free to include your recipe if you wish
6. Food entries judged on presentation, texture and taste
7. Entry is free and you may enter as many products as you wish in each category.
8. Entries can be dropped off prior to or on the day of the Festival (by 11.00am)
9. Judges' discretion as to how many places are awarded. Judges' decision is final.
